

Parents of 8th Grade Students

The following pictures are needed of your 8th grader:

1. **Graduation Memory Board**– a committee will put together some memory boards of pictures from K–8th grade to be displayed in the school hallways starting in May and then moved to the entry hallway the day of graduation. These pictures of your 8th grader can be from any grade or school event. It is always best to turn in copies—not original pictures. **Group pictures work best on the memory boards.**
2. **Graduation K & 8th Board**– a committee will put together picture boards of the 8th grade students which include both a kindergarten picture and an 8th grade picture next to one another of each student. It's fun for the students and parents to see how the kids have changed over the years. **We need one kindergarten picture and one 8th grade picture from each student.**

Please send in copies of original pictures for these projects. Pictures can be misplaced, lost, or not returned from the vendor. In most cases original pictures are returned but that cannot always be guaranteed.

For many reasons, separate pictures must be turned in for the boards and the video (discussed on an earlier handout). These projects have overlapping timelines.

Your 8th grader's year is going by quickly. Soon you'll turn around and it will be graduation day. Hopefully, you have already taken many photos, keep taking them and make copies early so the yearbook/memory boards/video will be a wonderful representation of all 8th grade students.

When turning in pictures to the office, please mark the envelope with the following:

- 8th grade Memory Board
- 8th grade K & 8 Board
- 8th grade Video
